CITRUS APPEAL



Surprisingly easy to grow, several varieties of citrus can fill your indoor rooms with glossy green foliage, sweet-smelling flowers and tasty fruit. Here's how to bring a bit of the tropics indoors this winter:

Choosing Plants

Though many citrus are easily started from seed, it can take several years for plants to flower and fruit. Start with mature potted plants for best success.

Meyer Lemon - The attractive foliage and fruit of Meyer lemon make it a great indoor choice.
Ht: 3ft Sp: 2ft

Key Lime - The most widely grown lime worldwide. A great variety for growing indoors, Key Lime produces small fruit with genuine tropical flavour.
Ht: 3-4ft Sp: 2ft

Calamondin Orange - The easiest citrus to grow indoors. Even in lower light conditions, plants will flower twice per year and will regularly produce attractive and aromatic oranges. Ht: 3ft Sp: 2ft

Caring for your Citrus

Citrus will require a brightly lit spot and consistent humidity to produce fruit. Fertilize bi-weekly with Miracle Gro 24-8-16 water soluble fertilizer.
