

# Mighty 'Matos

**MIGHTY 'MATO**

Mighty 'Matos are a new line of grafted tomato. Grafted vegetables are created when the top part of one plant (the scion) is attached to the root system of a separate plant (the rootstock). The rootstock contributes vigor and disease resistance while the scion is chosen for fruit flavor or quality.

Benefits of Mighty 'Mato vs. a non-grafted tomato plant:

- Extreme vigor for improved quality of fruit and a much larger yield.
- Tolerance to environmental stresses like extreme temperatures or poor soils.
- More abundant harvest over a longer period of time.
- Increased disease resistance including resistance to early and late blight and blossom end rot.



See the difference: this photo shows a non-grafted 'Big Beef' tomato plant (left) grown right next to a Mighty 'Mato 'Big Beef' tomato (right). Planting time and care were identical for both tomatoes.

Here are some important tips for success with grafted tomatoes:

- Plant grafted tomato directly into ground OR into large planter (min. 24x24" pot). Incorporate Off the Vine granular fertilizer at time of planting.



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- Ensure graft is planted above soil level.
- Stake or cage plants when planting.
- Plants are vigorous; pinch and prune often. Neglecting to do so will result in a lower yield.
- Check daily for water, and mulch plants with bark mulch/straw to help retain moisture.
- Fertilize plants weekly with 15-30-15 water soluble fertilizer or liquid kelp.
