

Great Spring Bulbs to Start Early Indoors

Calla Lilies: One of the spring bulbs that *should* be started early indoors. Growing your own Calla is a great idea; the unusual cup shaped blossoms cost a pretty penny at the florist shop!



Black Forest - Satiny black blooms on glossy green foliage. Very unique colour.



Millenium Gold - Beautiful golden yellow blooms over spotty green foliage. Would look amazing with any purple flowering annuals.

Dahlia: These traditional favourites get a real head start when started early indoors. Not only a colourful cut flower, Dahlia foliage will help fill in a large planter quickly.



Tahiti Sunrise - This cactus Dahlia has bright yellow blooms tipped with rosy red. Spiky blooms are an excellent cutflower
