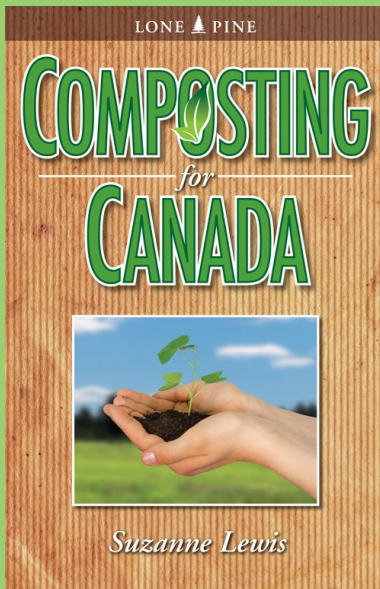


MAY 2-8 IS INTERNATIONAL COMPOSTING AWARENESS WEEK
